Excerpts from the Golden Light Sutra

From pristine limbs, the Buddhas' sun Radiates shafts of golden light.

As soon as [they] the Buddhas are born, their bodies illuminate The triple realms and all ten directions' worlds; Limitless suffering is dispelled by this light And sentient beings are sustained with all happiness.
